Chris' leadership in the Japanese community in Hawaii spans decades and includes serving as past board chair of the Honolulu Japanese Chamber of Commerce, United Japanese Society of Hawaii and co-chair of the 150th Anniversary of the Gannenmono Celebration. She currently serves as Chair of the Pan Pacific Festival Advisory Committee, director of the Hiroshima Kenjinkai and Hawaii Aloha Life Enrichment Association. She is a member of the Board of Governors and the Immediate Past Chair of the Japanese Cultural Center of Hawaii.
